The Definition of a Supervisor

- S: Setting a good example to all by your safe work practices.
- U: Understanding your role in workplace safety.
- P: Preparing your employees to do the job right, the first time and every time.
- **E:** Educating your employees in safe lifting techniques.
- R: Reducing the potential for slips/ trips and falls on stairs, ladders, and same level.
- V: Visibility and accessibility to all employees daily is the key.
- I: Insisting that employees follow all established work rules and procedures.
- S: Sending the safety message to all; conduct 5 minute safety talk on a daily basis.
- O: Organizing the workplace, so work tasks make sense for production as well as safety.
- R: Responsibility to all:
 - To yourself- be the good example
 - To your employees- they look to you to teach them to be safe
 - To your company- they expect you to lead by example
 - To your livelihood- it's what you're paid to do by your company
 - To your family- they want you home safe with them every night
